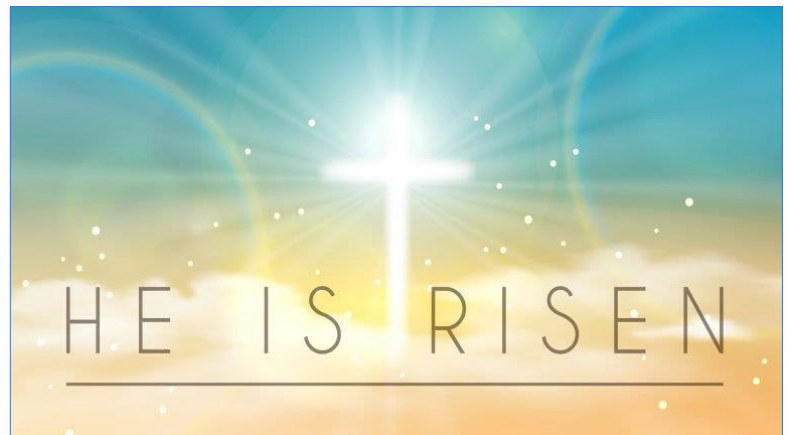

Saints,

We celebrated Holy Week with three services this year: Maudy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday. Easter season or Eastertide is 50 days and culminates on Pentecost, its Resurrection season! We look forward to worshipping with Bishop Kevin on Sunday the 12th. +Kevin will preach and celebrate the Eucharist. As is our parish tradition we will have a potluck lunch after the service. The weather forecast as of this writing is sunny and sixty degrees, snow shouldn't be an issue!

The first step in our renovations is permitting by the borough and the official sale of the rectory. We believe the permits will be done within the next two weeks. If God is with us, and I believe He is, we should be able to start with the masonry repairs over the summer. We will keep the parish updated as we begin to make progress.

Sadly, Cindy Mack has submitted her resignation for the middle of June. She has done a superb job as our organist and she will be missed. We'll contact the Guild of Organists to run an ad for her replacement.

On a scriptural note, completing John's gospel, readings from Acts, and Paul's letters give us insights on just what the resurrection means and how it affects us as disciples. Stay with us this Easter season as we walk with the disciples and the resurrected Christ on the road to Emmaus.

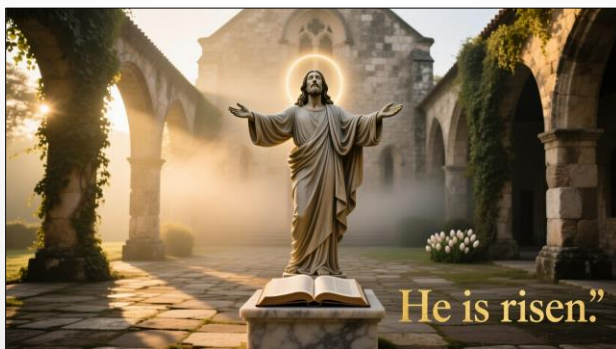


The Collect:

The Sunday of the Resurrection – Easter Sunday

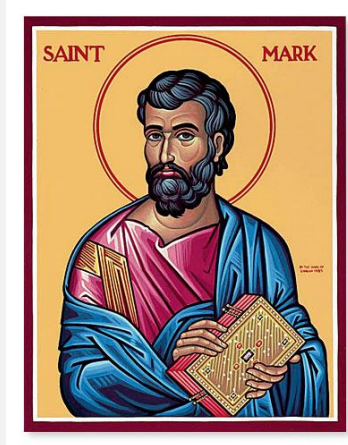


The Collect:

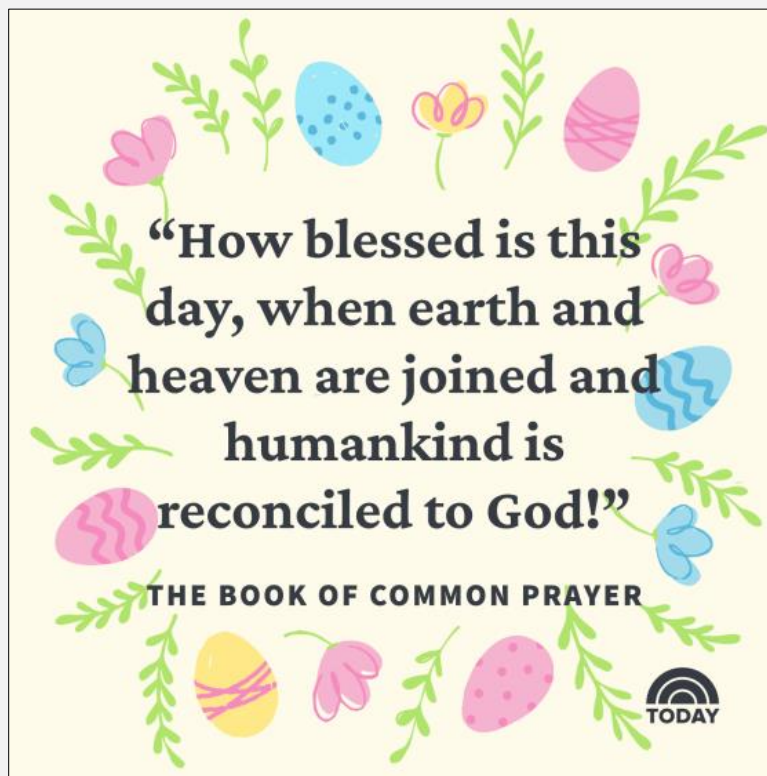

Monthly Summary – February 2026

Total income for the month was \$12,726.25 of which \$3,689.00 was pledge income and Packer Endowment Income of \$6,650. Expenses for the month totaled \$8,857.60 leaving a **balance** for the month of \$3,868.65. The Building Fund Income for the month totaled \$70.00 and Debt Reduction Income totaled \$285.00.

Total income year to date was \$18,402.55 with total expenses of \$18,915.77 leaving a **deficit** for the year of \$513.22.

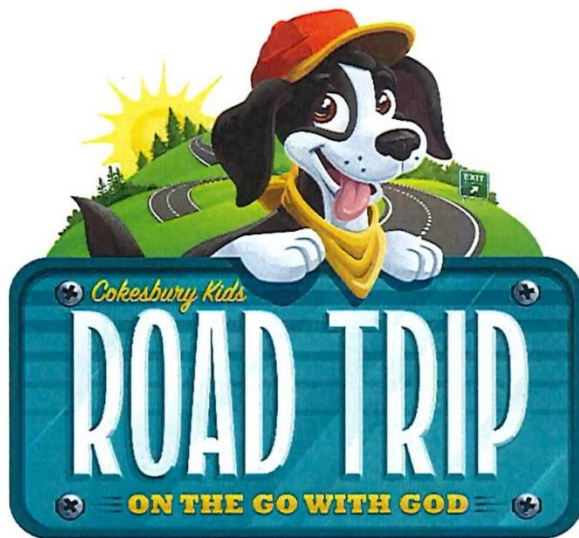

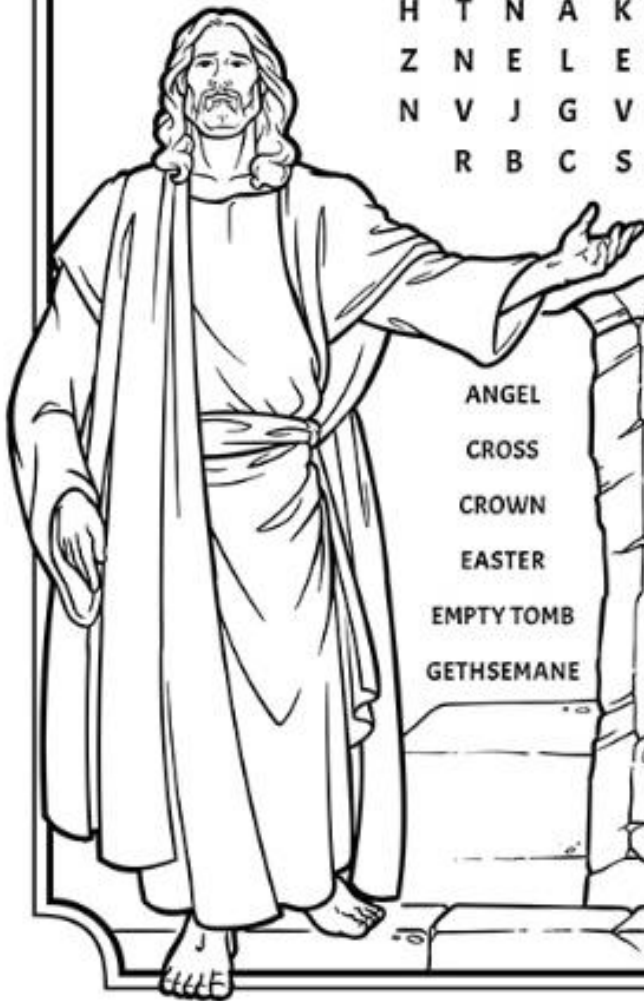
