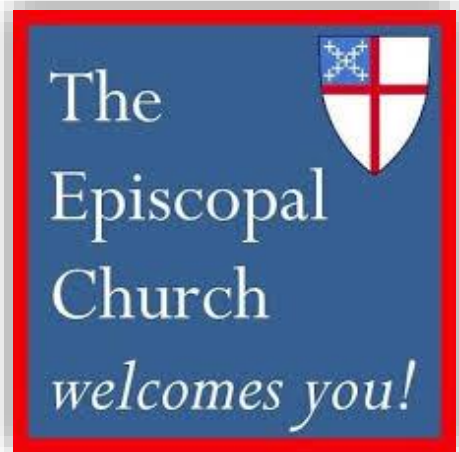

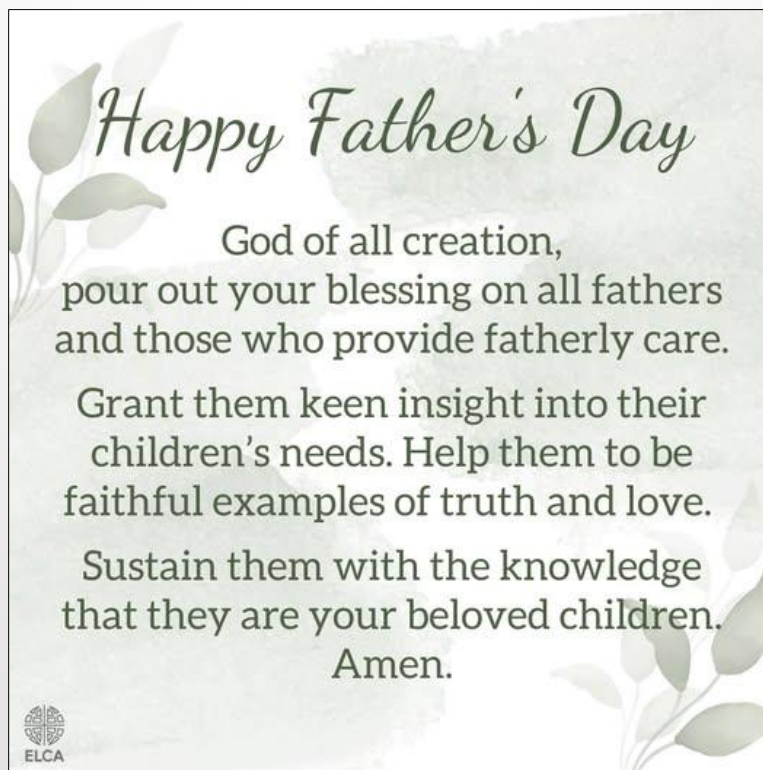


*The Collect:*

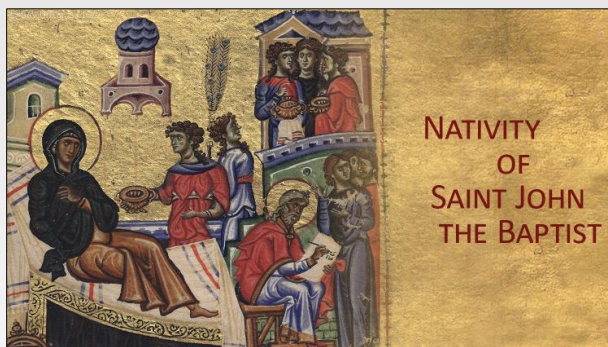

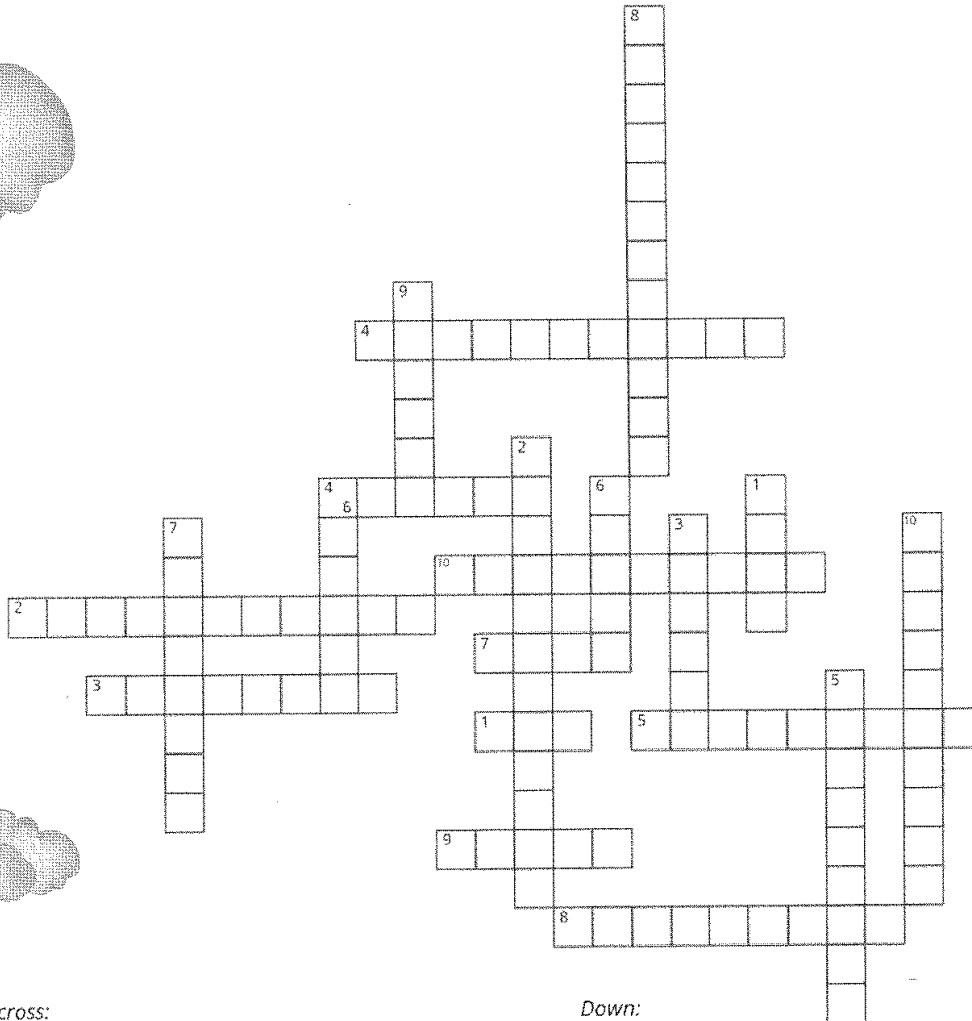

## *From the All Saints Fundraising Committee:*

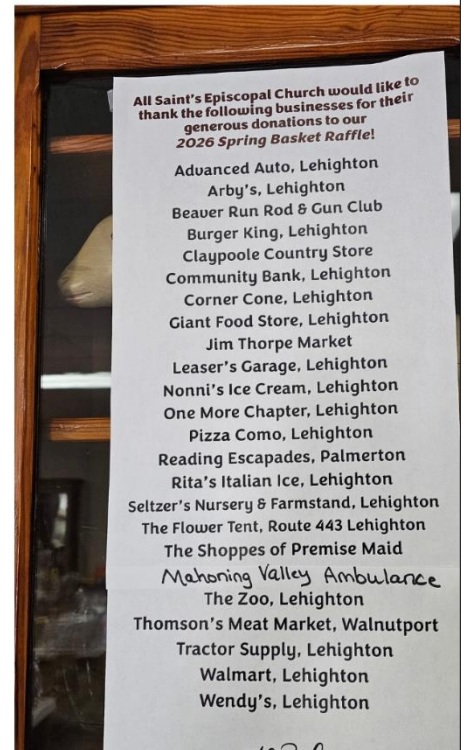

## Monthly Summary – April 2026

Total income for the month was \$9,670.25 of which \$6,370.00 was pledge income and \$944.00 was Holiday. Expenses for the month totaled \$10,206.89 leaving a **deficit** for the month of \$586.64. The Building Fund Income for the month totaled \$155.00 and Debt Reduction Income totaled \$245.00.

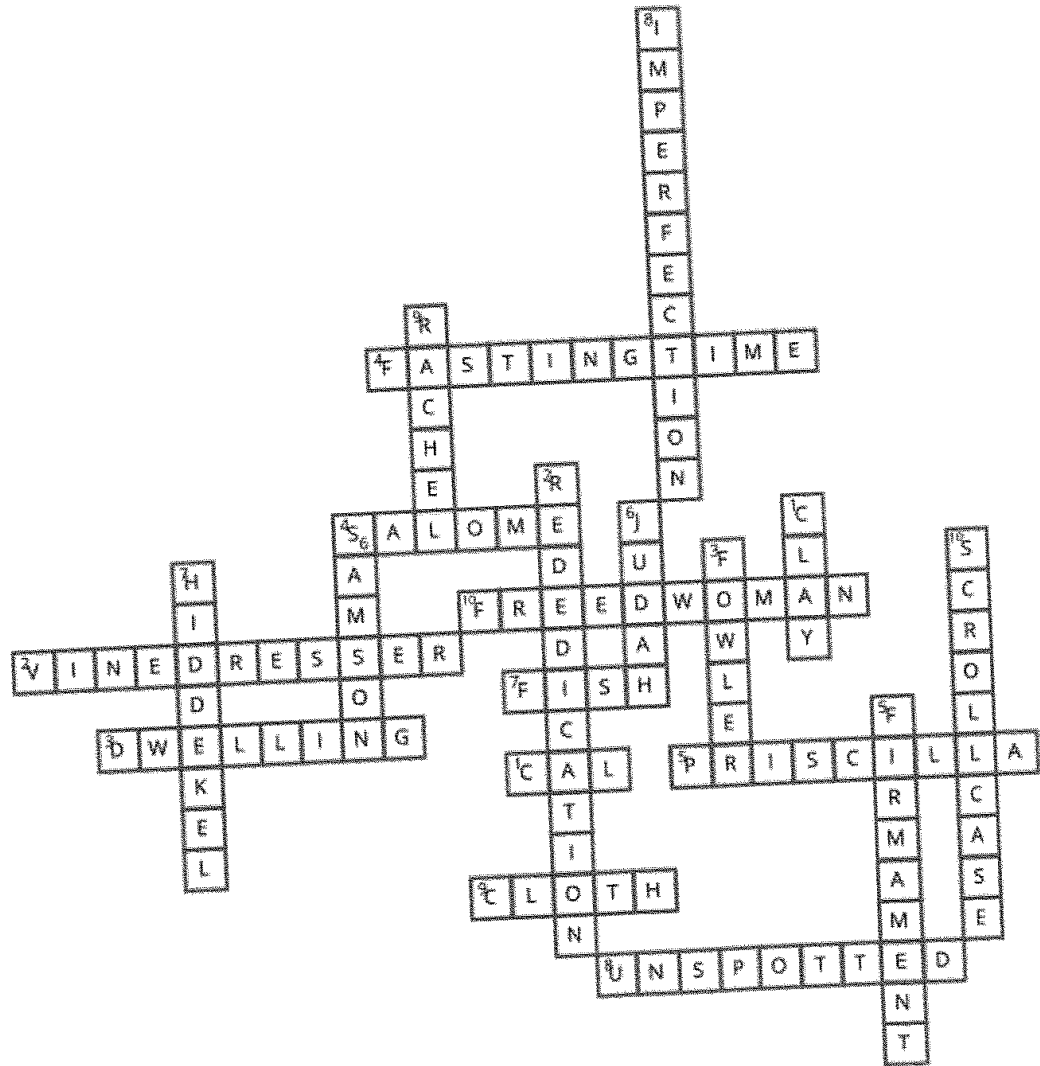
